Tips for a Successful Yard Sale (courtesy of our neighbors from Woodbine)

- Ask a neighbor if they would like to go in on the yard sale together. Multi-family yard sales are more attractive to buyers.
- Put your pets indoors or in your backyard. People are afraid or allergic to pets and may avoid a yard sale because of this.
- Have plenty of small bills and change on hand. Use a fanny pack for keeping change.

- Use your driveway and place the pay table at the end so buyers spend more time at your yard sale.
- Keeping a cooler of cold water, lemonade or soft drinks to either give to or sell to buyers.
- Consider playing music to create a festive atmosphere for buyers.
